RESERVE ACTIVE AND LONG SERVICE MEMBERSHIP

Bronte SLSC criteria and application process for transitioning from Active membership to RA or LS

RESERVE ACTIVE MEMBERSHIP

Reserve Active Membership is granted to Active Members who have satisfactorily completed (after gaining the Bronze Medallion) at least eight (8) years of patrol and club obligations as provided by the SLSA and Club Constitution.

Reserve Active membership is not automatic, it is granted by resolution by the Club Board of Management (BOM)

Reserve Active Members must remain proficient in their relevant awards and shall perform a minimum number of patrol hours (see below) while they hold Reserve Active membership.

Qualification for Reserve Active membership

To qualify for Reserve Active status members are required to have logged a minimum of thirty (30) hours per season for eight (8) seasons.

NOTE: In exceptional circumstances, the BOM may grant Reserve Active membership to Active Members, irrespective of years of service.

LONG SERVICE MEMBERSHIP

Long Service membership may be granted to members who have completed ten (10) years Active service or to members who have completed eight (8) years Active service plus two (2) years Reserve Active service.

Such members are exempted from all patrol obligations and may be granted other special privileges of Membership as provided in the Clubs Constitution.

Should such Members join another Affiliated Club the receiving Club shall determine if such Members Long Service shall be recognised by that Club.

Qualification for Long Service membership

In order to qualify for Long Service at Bronte SLSC members are required to have accrued a minimum of 30 hours per season for eight (8) seasons, as well as twelve (12) hours per season for 2 seasons.

NOTE: In exceptional circumstances, the BOM may grant Long Service membership to Active or Reserve Active Members, irrespective of years of service.

CHECKLIST BEFORE SUBMITTING AN APPLICATION

Reserve Active

- Current financial member of Bronte SLSC
- Obtained Bronze Medallion a minimum of eight (8) years ago
- Accrued a minimum of thirty (30) patrol hours per season for eight (8) seasons*

Long Service

- Current financial member of Bronte SLSC
- Obtained Bronze Medallion a minimum of 10 years ago
- Accrued a minimum of thirty (30) patrol hours per season for eight (8) seasons*
- Accrued a minimum of twelve (12) patrol hours per season for a further two (2) seasons*

***Confirm your accrued patrol hours prior to submitting an application**

Login to your SLS Members Area and confirm that you meet the minimum patrol hours required in the criteria detailed above

- You will receive a confirmation of your email request.
- Your membership record will be checked to ensure you meet the minimum requirements set out in the checklist above.
- If you meet the minimum requirements your request will be submitted to the BOM for approval at the next* management meeting and you will be notified of the outcome.
- If you do not meet the minimum eligibility requirements you will be advised by email. You can in extenuating circumstances request a review of eligibility and submit supporting evidence for special consideration.

*Management meetings are held approximately every 2-3 months.

Please note Long Service members are not required to patrol and can elect to be removed from your current team. However, if you choose to remain on a rostered patrol team you are required to attend all patrols or find a substitute.
